The NWCSP Data and Information workstream has identified the need for the NHS to make better use of technology to support clinical staff when working directly with patients and their wounds. Whilst in their infancy, Wound Management Digital Systems are anticipated to reduce variation in wound assessment and treatment practices, improve compliance with guidelines, improve healing rates, facilitate remote review and release clinical time. In addition, they will play a pivotal role in supporting the collection of data for quality and improvement purposes by automatically collecting this data secondary to routine clinical care.

This register has been developed to provide an overview of commercial stakeholders who have identified themselves and their products to the Digital, Data & Information workstream. The register presents a brief summary of the products as understood at the date of the meeting and is not a comprehensive overview of each product or the market.
